

Addition to the Laryngectomee's Travel Guide 2013


Members who have already requested a copy of the 2013 guide might like to add the contact details for Leicester which have been notified to us recently:

These cards have proved extremely useful in acting in an aid of memory and are extremely useful to medical staff in an emergency.


